There are several benefits to hiking with a guide: first of all they know the best routes. They can also regale you with intriguing stories about the country and its people.



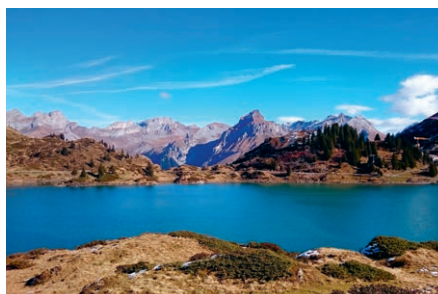
Bürgenstock Alpine Golf

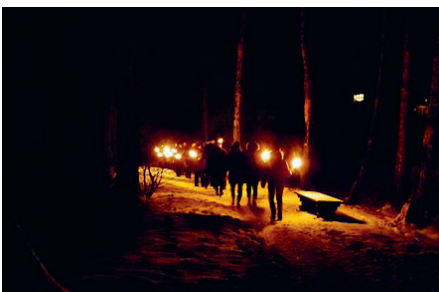
Fat Bike tour

Explore the romantic Felsenweg and of course the legendary 152.8 m high Hammetschwand Lift with its unbeatable view directly from the resort.



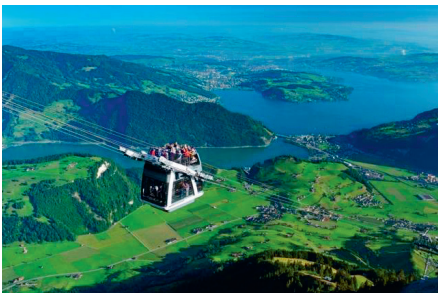

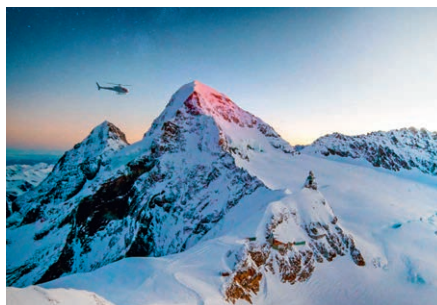
Mt. Pilatus – the steepest rack railway in the world

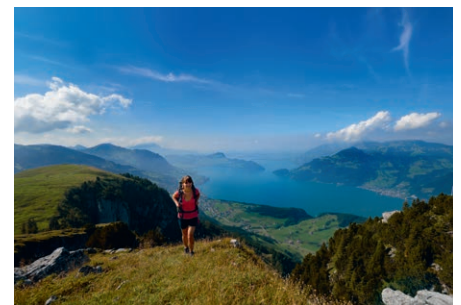
Titlis Rotair
