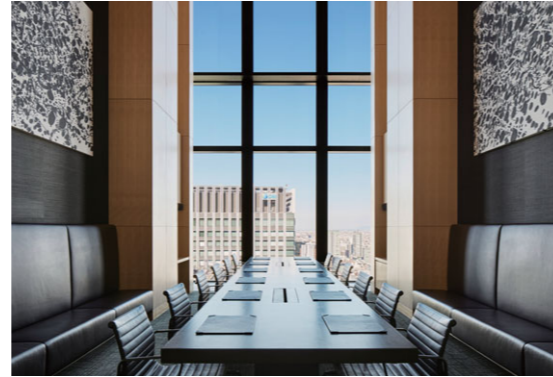

### The Restaurant by Aman

- Serves casual French fare
- Offers indoor and outdoor dining
- Green views of the Otemachi Forest

### The Lounge by Aman

- Open throughout the day and into the night

- Spectacular floor-to-ceiling views over Tokyo
- Includes a Japanese-style garden lounge, bar and cigar lounge

An exclusive sanctuary high above Japan's cosmopolitan capital, Aman Tokyo is Aman's first urban concept hotel, situated adjacent to the Otemachi Forest. Offering bird's eye views of the Imperial Palace Gardens and surrounding Tokyo landmarks, the hotel features a serene Aman Spa and a peaceful inner garden. Surrounded by engawa, a wooden feature dividing the inside and out, the soaring lobby rises nearly 30 metres.

- Offers views of Imperial Palace Gardens, Tokyo Skytree®, Mount Fuji
- Close to Imperial Palace Gardens and Ginza shopping district

## Getting There

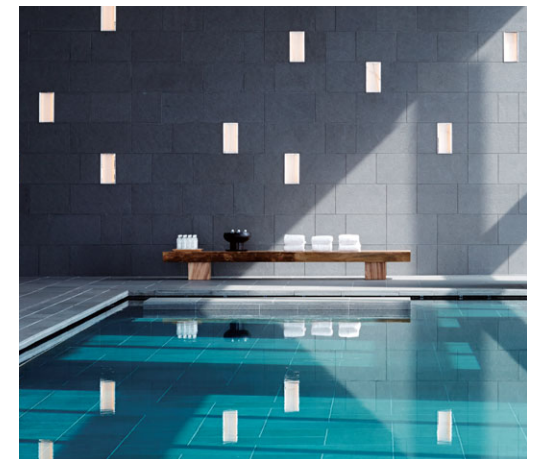
- The Otemachi Tower is connected to five-line Otemachi subway station

- Haneda Airport (35-min drive) handles domestic and international flights
